Waagerecht:

- 2 Symbol in sheet music, defining the pitch
- 4 Phrase or melody that is repeated after each verse of a song
- 8 A piece of wire or cord, can be plucked or played.
- 11 Someone who makes music
- 12 Tone color, quality of sound. Distinguishes instruments
- 15 One of the two modes of the tonal system
- 17 The length of a note, beat
- 18 Religious song

Senkrecht:

- 1 Piece of music written for two vocalists or instrumentalists
- 2 Group of singers
- 3 A large group of instrumentalists playing together
- 5 Making music with one's own voice
- 6 Successive notes of a key/mode ascending or descending
- 7 Composition for orchestra
- 8 Verse of a song
- 9 Stringed instrument with a long neck and a flat, hollow body
- 10 The interval between notes with the same letter name
- 13 Family of wind instruments
- 14 A drama where the words are sung instead of spoken
- 16 Keyboard instrument, sound is produced by forcing air through pipes
